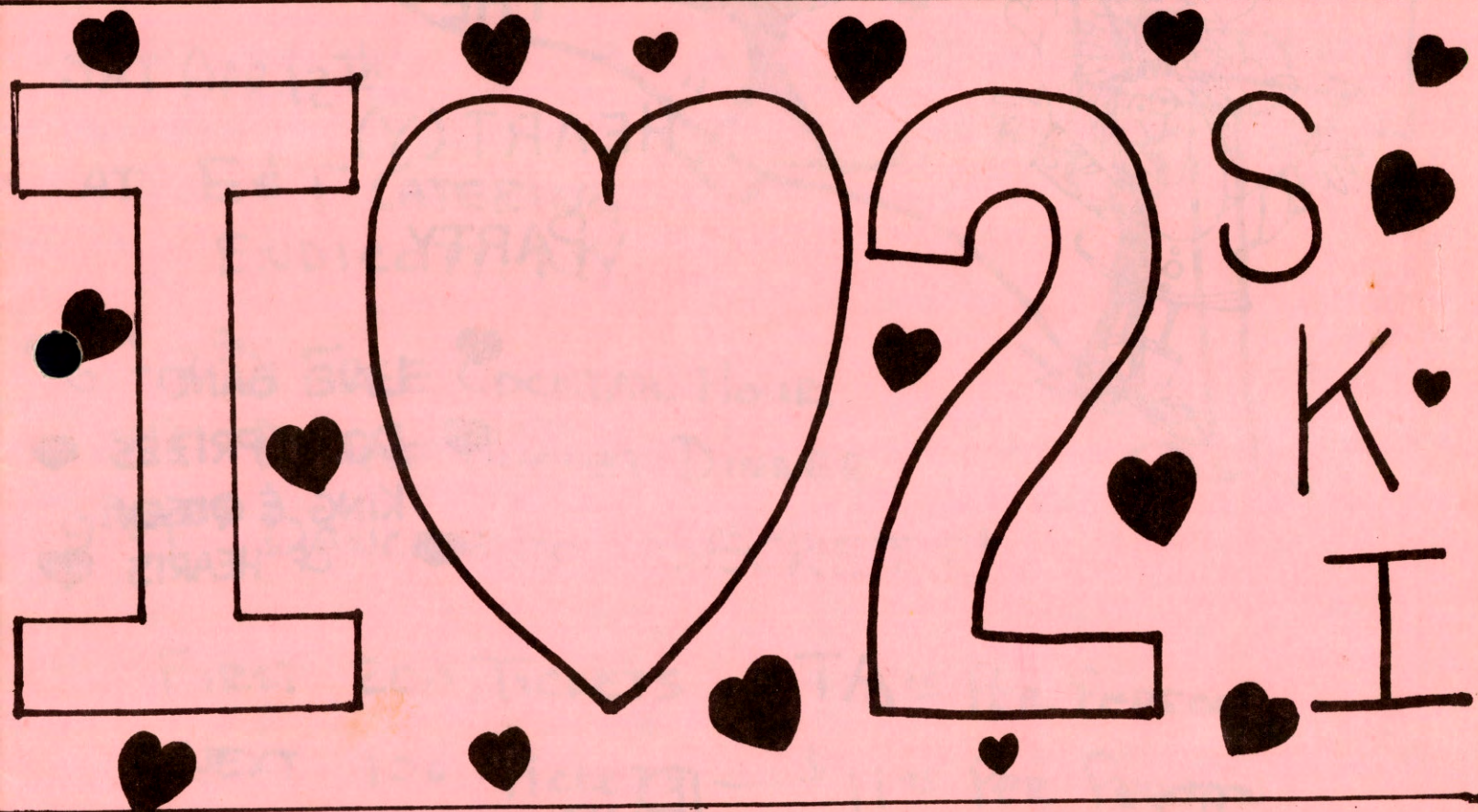

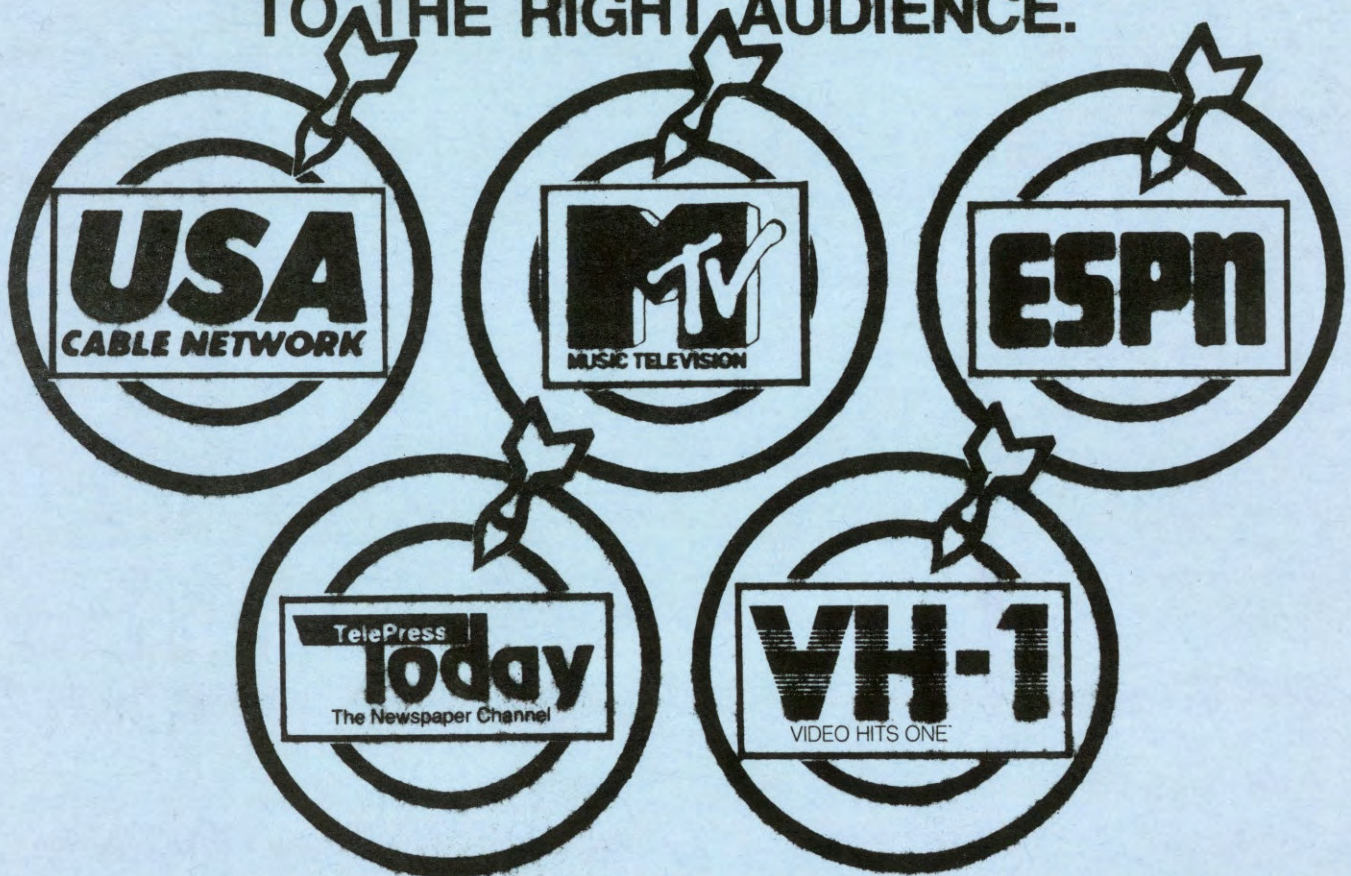

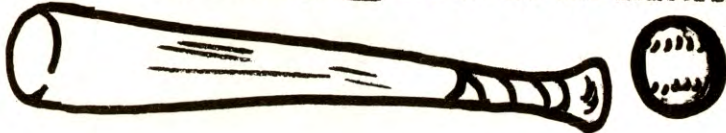


SOFTBALL 1986

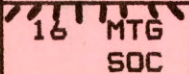
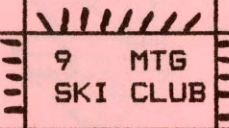

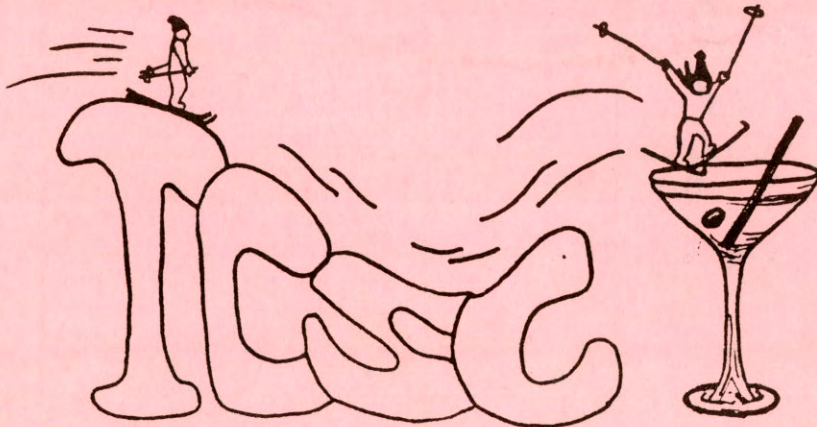
