

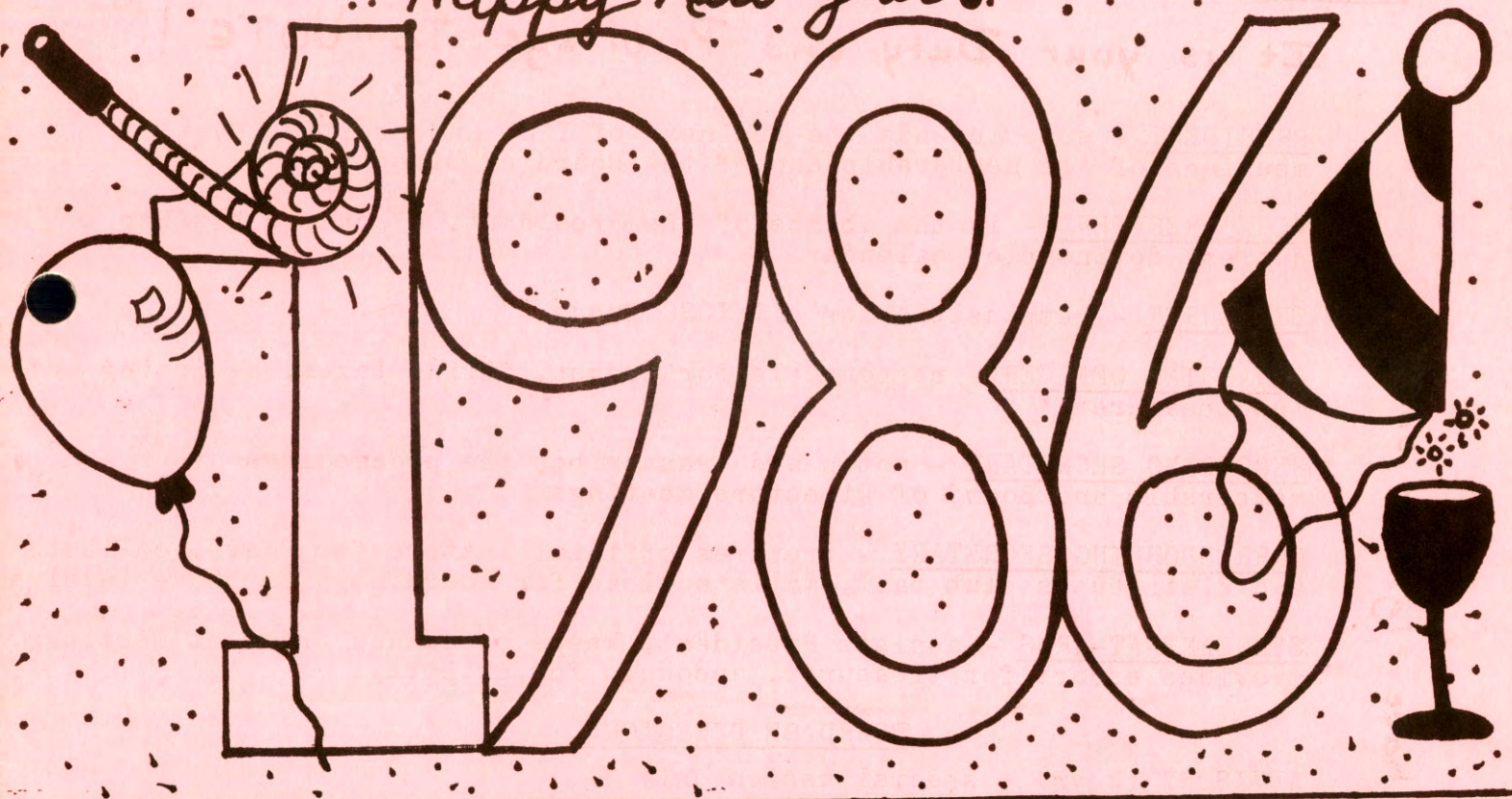

JUDICIAL COMMITTEE - need 5 people, 1 yr terms, don't vote, rule on Board actions, interpret the Constitution.

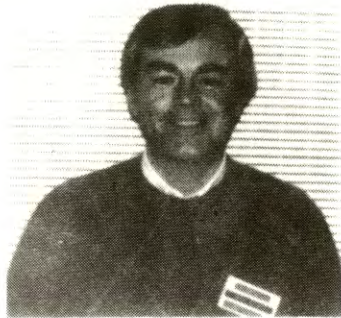

MT SNOW - HUNTER I - WHITEFACE - SMUGGLERS NOTCH - These trips are sold out and have waiting lists - please contact trip leader for information.

TOGGENBURG

New Trip!!! Toggenburg Ski-N-Party Night. Ski, party, and dance with the ski clubs from Rochester, Auburn, Syracuse, and Utica. Third annual private Ski-N-Party Night. Trip includes: bus, lift tickets, beer, wine, soda, H'ovs dourves, and band. Cost \$26.00 (Party & Bus \$18.00).

HUNTER II - Sold out - No waiting list

Friday trip including continental breakfast and a prime rib dinner. 16 lifts, 44 trails, 100% snowmaking, 2 hour ride from Binghamton.

SUGARBUSH - Sold out - No waiting list

Sugarbush is a 3 day trip this year. Stay in 3 and 4 bedroom condominiums with fireplaces and full kitchen. Enjoy happy hours before dinner at nearby lodge and after dinner parties in the condos or night spots. Ski Sugarbush and Sugarbush North which offer 15 lifts, 80 trails, 2600' vertical and extensive top to bottom snowmaking. Excellent cross-country skiing available in the area.

LABRADOR

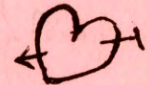

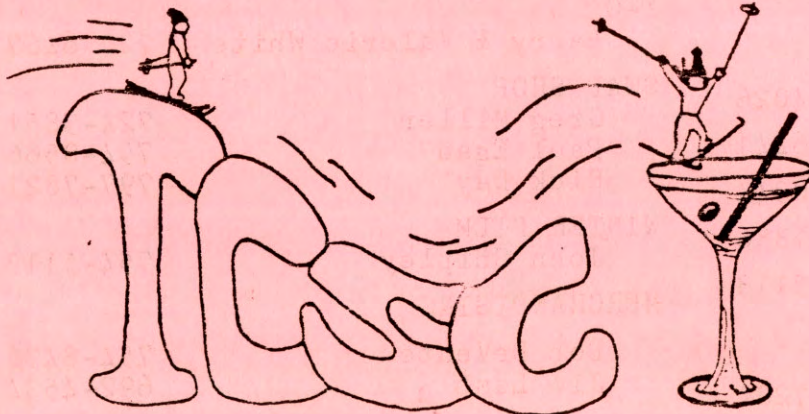
