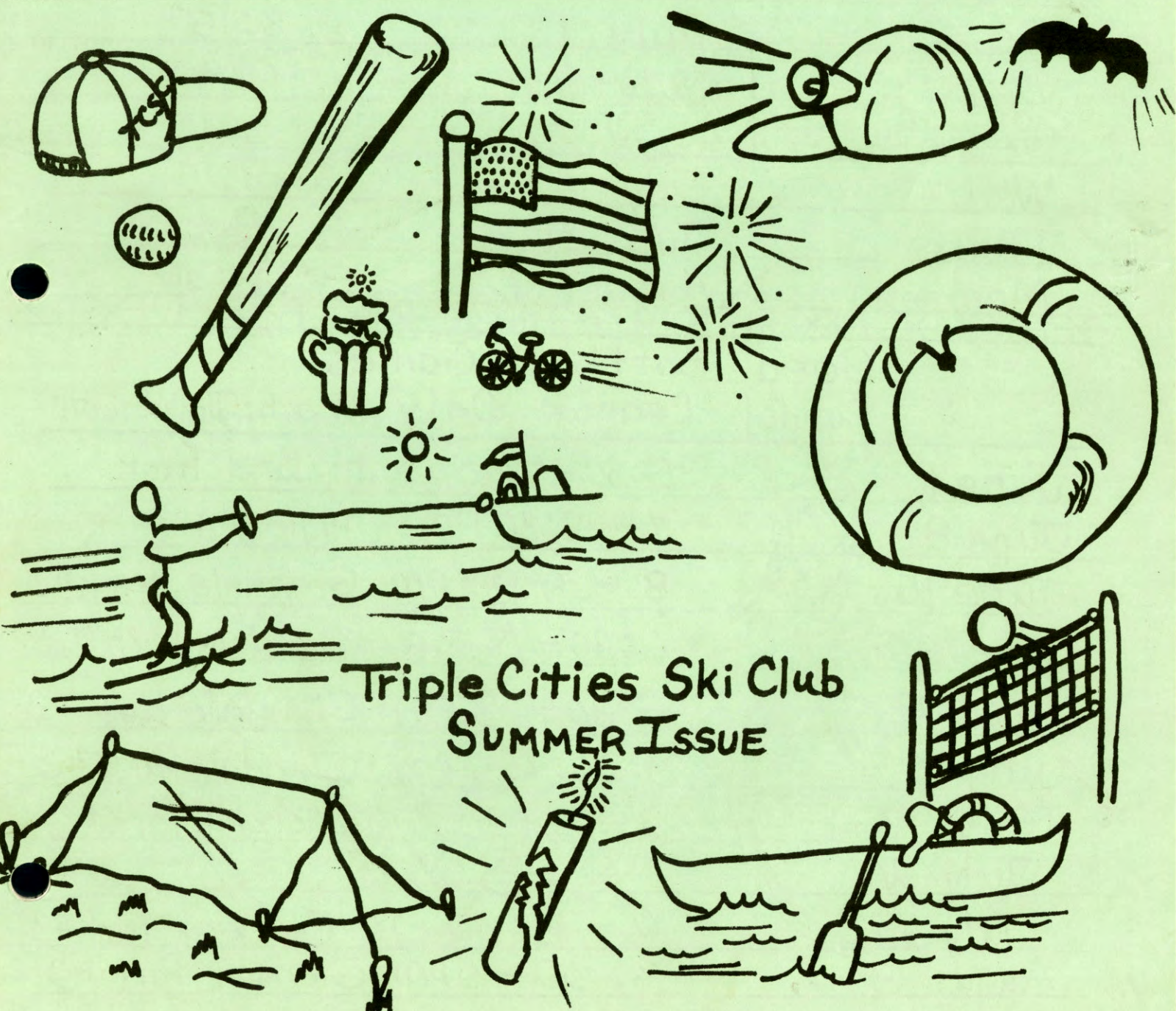

We will visit a water fall, a small park by the river for lunch, an old grave yard, a basket shop, and finally ice cream!

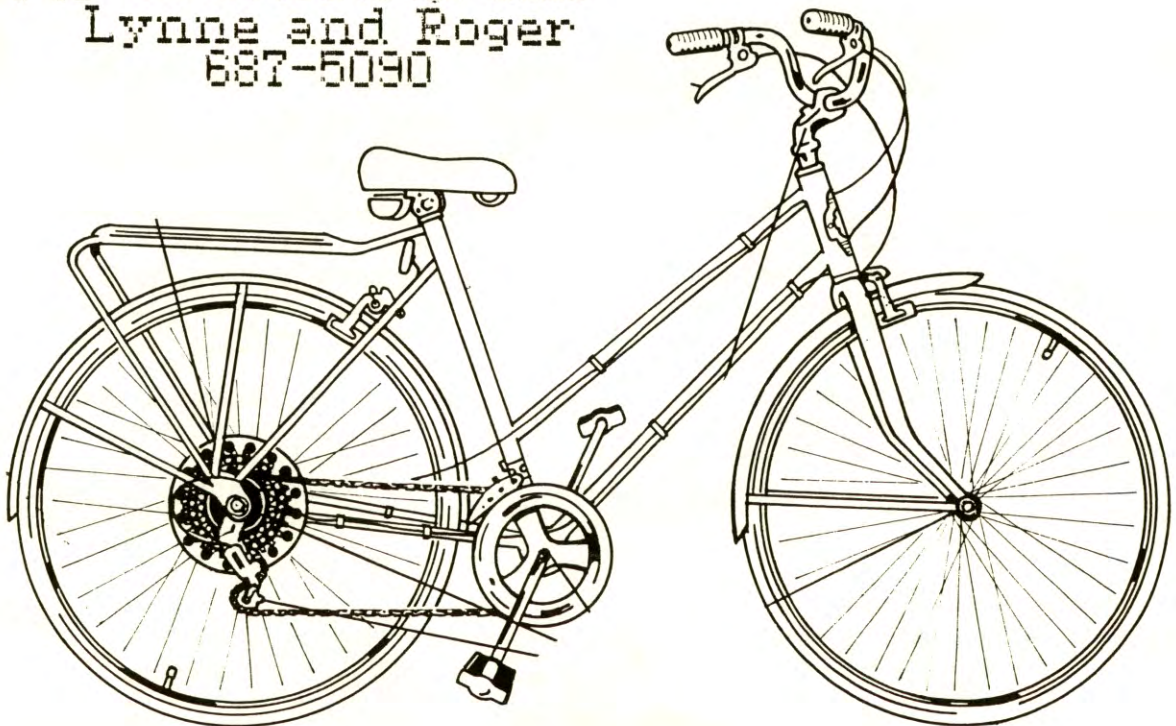

# Caving

This is the real thing, folks! No paved walkways, electrically lit walls, tour guides, or cute names for formations.

I have chosen two caves to explore, which are very typical of the caves in this area. Caves are formed by water cutting through limestone, so each of these caves have small streams in them, and some of the basic formations. I will even go so far as to promise a bat.

This is a rugged trip ... you will be expected to be in good physical condition, be able to supply a hardhat/helmet, and three sources of light (e.g. carbide lamp, flashlights, candles, etc.), and not be afraid of cold, dark, wet places.

Caving is a lot of fun! It's like hiking in a whole new world. Come on and give it a try !!!

Date : Sunday, June 8th- all day (~~8AM~~ 8AM to 8PM).  
Transportation : Car pool.  
Place : Schoharie Cty, New York (in the Howe Cavern area.)  
Cost : Share of gas expenses, and dinner (about \$10 total).

Wear : VERY OLD CLOTHES. You will get very muddy! You must wear some sort of tough footwear ... hiking boots or workboots are strongly recommended ... sneakers will not give adequate grip. Caves are about 50 degrees all year round, so you need a few layers. Also bring a change of clothes/shoes and a sturdy garbage bag to put your mucky clothes in for the trip home

TCSC FIRST EVER OVERNIGHT CANOE TRIP

WHEN: Aug. 1-3 (Fri-Sat-Sun)

WHERE: DELAWARE RIVER  
Between Buckingham, PA and Skinner's Falls, NY.  
Approximately 15 miles south of Hancock.

HOW MUCH: \$35 (With Your Canoe)                      \$61 (With Rental Canoe, \$5 deposit included)

TERMS: \$15 Deposit, \$20 or \$46 due July CANOE TRIP MEETING.  
\$5 CANCELLATION FEE before July CANOE TRIP MEETING.  
After the meeting, the CANCELLATION FEE will be whatever expenses are incurred on your behalf, up to \$35.

INCLUDED: 6 meals, camping, and canoe portage.

SCOOP: Arrive Red Barn Family Campground 7:00 PM Fri. Set up camp, enjoy friends and the famous TAILGATE buffet (from past ~~Water trips~~). Enjoy campfire and songs. Go to bed. Wake up Sat. to the aroma of fresh coffee, ~~donuts~~ and juice. Set out for up-river trek about 10 AM. 12 mi. ~~and~~ and people portage. Put in at Buckingham. Canoe most of day down river, subs for lunch. Arrive at camp late afternoon. Swim, fish, volleyball, shower, tube, go to church, help get steak dinner ready. After dinner sit ~~around~~ campfire party and tell tall tales about the days experiences, sing or walk across tracks to local saloon. Go to bed. About the river, it is mostly slow moving and very clean. It is also one of the best trout streams in the east. Right in front of our campsite is an ideal spot for catching Rainbow and Brown trout. So get your license and bring your rod.

At present, we have almost 40 deposits but can still take more. We must have your deposit and signed trip form to put you on the trip. You must also be a member of the club. Summer memberships are \$5. If you live at the same address as a \$5 member you can join for \$2.50.

The Polynsia holds 125 passengers and 45 crew so you will have an excellent opportunity to meet other people from a wide variety of backgrounds. We anticipate several mail-in registrations during the summer months. Registration will also be available at the September TCSC meeting (come early).

This a barefoot cruise - very casual, you live in your swimsuit 90% of the time. The Polynsia is a beautiful 4-masted schooner, 248 feet LOA, 36 foot beam. The upper deck is continuous from bow to stern and is a great place for sleeping under the stars.

Sailing is done mostly at night giving you the opportunity to explore the Islands during the day.

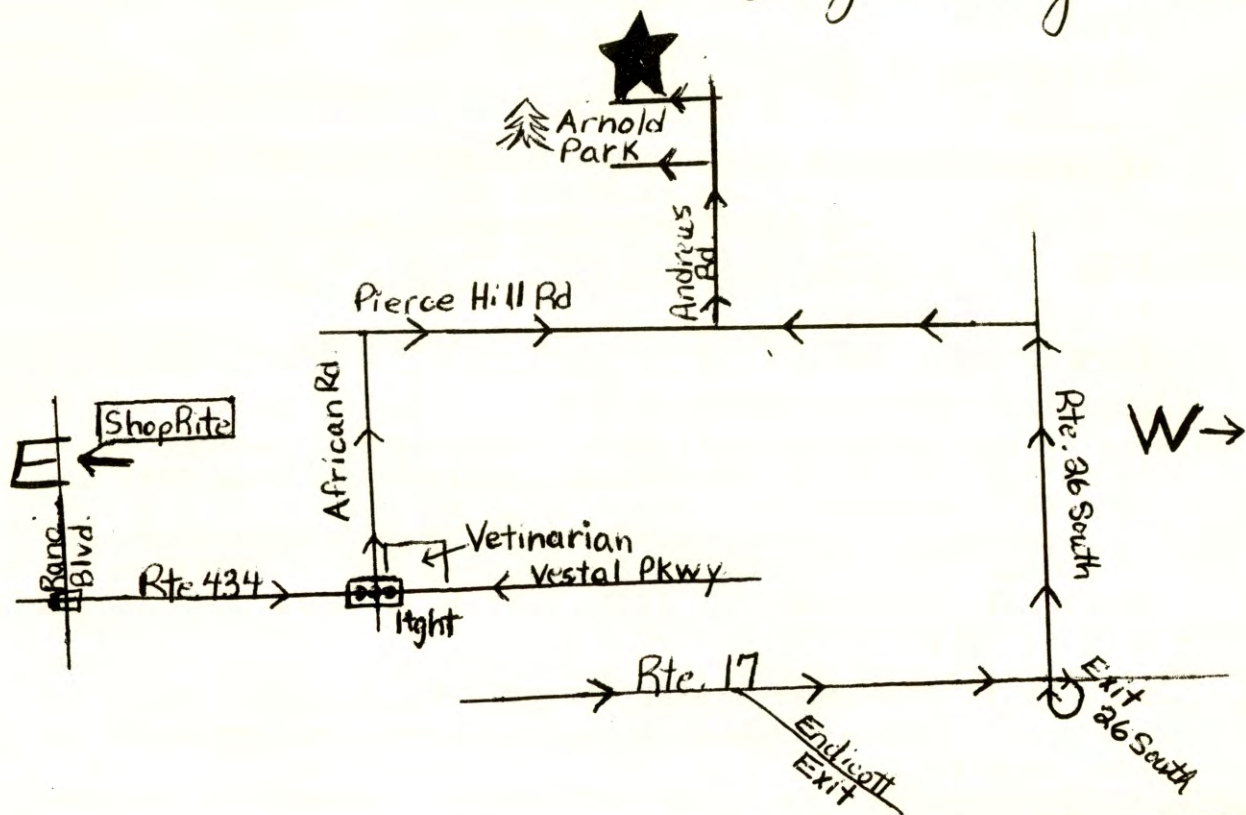

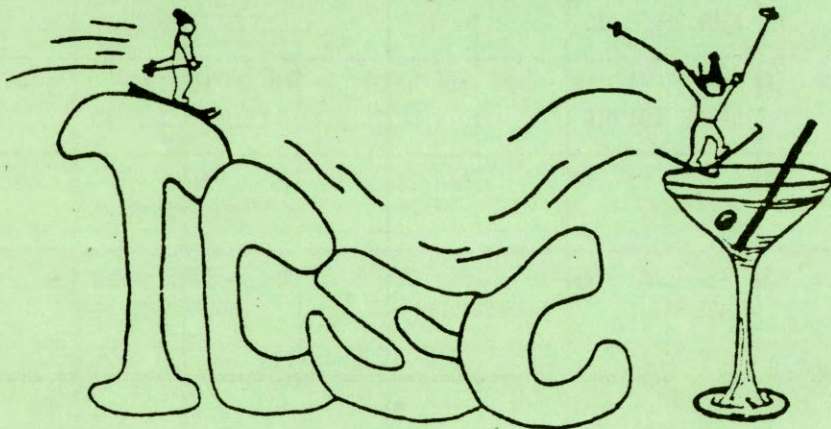
